Lifemark's Aspire program offers a welcoming, person-centred environment grounded in trauma-informed care, empowering people with disabilities to build skills, grow confidence, and achieve meaningful employment.

You may be eligible for Aspire if you are:

- Are a resident of Edmonton or the surrounding area
- Are 18 years of age or older
- Identify as a person with a disability (PWD)
- Are unemployed or marginally employed
- Are legally able to work and train in Canada

Centre4Work is open to Albertans who are employed, unemployed, marginally employed, or self-employed.
