Lifemark CARES (Career Advancement and Resources for Employment Success) addresses the challenges that parents and guardians face in returning to work or in improving their work situation.

Benefit from a holistic approach which facilitates job placement and assists parents to improve their work situation and remove barriers that impede access to meaningful employment.

You may be eligible if you are:

- A parent and/or guardian who is ready to work but may face barriers to employment
- Currently unemployed, underemployed or marginally employed
- A resident of the Calgary region
- Eighteen (18) years of age or older
- Legally eligible to work in Canada
- Facing barriers like childcare access, limited skills, transport issues, earning below living wage, working irregular shifts, and needing support to enhance employment

Program details

- Program is customizable: 12 to 16 weeks of services, with services available in-person or virtually
- Includes career and employment workshops, and industry-specific training
- Employment specific certifications available (eg. First aid, safety certifications, software training, etc.)
- Connection to volunteer opportunities, work experience, and job placement
- Access to wrap-around services such as kinesiology and mental health services
- Access to innovative services such as Lifemark's Clothing Closet, Food Pantry, Community Kitchen, Resource Centre, Virtual Career Centre, and more
