

Documents to verify your Indigenous heritage

In order to be considered for this scholarship you will have to provide documentation proving your Indigenous identity. Any of the following documents will be accepted:

- Certified copy of your Status Card
- A certified copy of a Métis Nation citizenship card from one of the provincial affiliates (Métis Nation of Ontario, Manitoba Metis Federation, Métis Nation Saskatchewan, Métis Nation of Alberta, Métis Nation British Columbia, Nation Metis Québec), a membership card from one of the Metis Settlements of Alberta or a membership card from the Northwest Territory Métis Nation
- Written confirmation of Métis identity by a Métis local, council or education authority within the Métis Nation homeland recognized by the Metis National Council
- Certified copy of an Inuit enrolment card issued by any one of the four Inuit modern treaty bodies—Nunavut, Nunatsiavut, Nunavik or Inuvialuit
- Written confirmation of membership from a federally recognized band

OR

- Declaration of identity

If you cannot provide the above documentation, please submit a declaration of identity. This must state your ongoing relationship to a legally recognized and inherent Indigenous community, nation, or people. Please state your Indigenous identity with specific information about your First Nation, Inuit, or Metis community; include details about your treaty, scrip, land claim, and territory or region.
